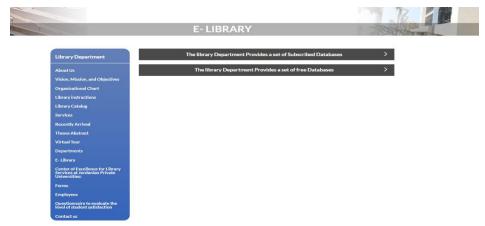

Amman Arab University Offers Training Courses for Local Community

Coping with Amman Arab University endeavors in strengthening the University's participation in serving and networking with local community, Information and Communication Technology Center, in cooperation with the Office of Relations and Social Responsibility at Amman Arab University, organized a training course in "Computer Basics" for a group of orphaned children sponsored by Ain Al-Basha Orphan Association.

The training course included a number of computer skills and themes, through which the trainees received a number of computer and applied skills in information technology, their importance and how to employ them in real life.

Prof. Mohamad Al-Widyan, president of the University, stated that the university aims to encourage the design of these initiatives, as part of its mission to develop a sense of social responsibility among its staff, and to provide support and support to less fortunate communities, stressing that the university is ready to host courses that serve the local community.

In this regard, the president of the association, Yousef Al-Nawaji, expressed his thanks and gratitude to Amman Arab University, represented by the president of the university, Prof. Mohamad Al-Widyan, for hosting such courses and for the efforts made to make this course a success. He extended special thanks to the course instructor, Eng. Anas Hassanein, and those in charge of the success of this course.

At the conclusion of the training courses, President of the University honored and distributed certificates and prizes in kind. Mr. Issam Fouda, Deputy Director of the Information and Communication Technology Center, expressed his gratitude and appreciation to the participants.









Awareness Lecture at "Amman Arab University" about the Reality of Organ Donation in Jordan

The Deanship of Student Affairs and the Health Center at Amman Arab University organized an awareness lecture entitled "The Reality of Organ Donation in Jordan" in cooperation with the Directorate of the Jordanian Center for Organ Transplantation, in the presence of Dr. The Directorate of the Jordanian Center for Organ Transplantation, Dr. Tariq Harb, a neurosurgery specialist at the Ministry of Health / Al-Bashir Hospital, a number of members of the teaching and administrative staff, and a group of students.

Dr. Al-Jarrah pointed out that organ donation saves many people who suffer from organ failure, in addition to it being considered as ongoing charity for the donor, and stressed that such lectures work to encourage students and the local community to donate organs.

Al-Rawajfeh reviewed the procedures followed in the Directorate of the Jordanian Center for Organ Transplantation, and included an overview of the Jordanian Center for Organ Transplantation and its tasks of supervising organ transplantation programs in institutions operating throughout the Kingdom and working to encourage donors. He said that there is a national record for organ donation, transfer and transplantation. Statistics of a number of donors and a number of beneficiaries, expressing that the center is open to anyone wishing to donate organs, encouraging attendees to donate organs.



In this regard, Dr. Harb spoke about cases of brain death, as well as the methods of determining brain dead, saying that the period of brain death is the fertile period for organ donation, explaining the mechanism of organ transplantation, the period during which organs are transplanted, and the organ's validity for transplantation, as well as the effects of organ transplantation for the donor and beneficiary. He also talked about the donated organs, stressing that organ donation is a national and humanitarian duty. Many questions were asked by the audience, which were answered by Dr. Harb.

At the end of the lecture, an extensive dialogue took place during which the lecturers answered the attendees' questions and inquiries, and souvenir shields from the university were presented to the lecturers.





A Workshop Entitled "Preparing and Writing Educational Plans" for Amman Arab University students

The Deanship of Student Affairs/Office of Career Guidance and Graduate Follow-up at Amman Arab University, in cooperation with the College of Educational and Psychological Sciences, held a training workshop entitled "Preparing and Writing Educational Plans", where the implementation of this workshop came as one of the training courses and workshops implemented by the office within the portfolio of student skills, , which aimed to guide students on how to prepare educational plans and how to write them in terms of their importance and components to benefit from them in their future working lives.

It is noteworthy that based on the principle of continuity of communication between Amman Arab University and the university's graduates, this workshop was presented by one of the university's graduates, Mr. Abdul Rahman Al-Awamra, a graduate of the Faculty of Educational and Psychological Sciences - Special Education, in order to transfer practical experiences from graduate students to university students.

College of Computer Sciences and Informatics at "Amman Arab University" Holds a Workshop on Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement

College of Computer Sciences and Informatics at Amman Arab University, organized by the Quality Assurance Committee in the college, implemented a workshop for members of the faculty members and administrative staff at the college. The Dean of the College, Dr. Hossam Al-Hamad, welcomed all faculty members of the college and administrative staff, and emphasized the importance of continuous improvement of the academic programs and the link between the course file and direct and indirect assessment tools with the cycle of improvement.

The workshop included a detailed explanation of all course file models, including Course Specifications, Course Syllabus, Course Report, Course Assessment Report (CAR), evaluation tools in force according to the nature of the course, and e-learning integration rates. During the workshop, the mechanism for completing the continuous improvement cycle in all courses and programs was presented, and the role of the Quality Assurance Committee and the Academic Support Committee at the university level was presented in following up the continuous improvement cycle in academic departments.
